I would like to take this opportunity to introduce our company, American CPR Care Association (ACCA), which has offered a wide range of medical training courses for several years to a growing population. We provide certification and recertification options for all of our courses.

At ACCA, we teach our courses online or through a blended, hands-on skills training. Our online courses are self-paced and very descriptive, with a final quiz that individuals must pass for certification. Our hands-on courses are conducted virtually with a student to instructor ratio of 6 to 1. When a student chooses the hands-on skill assessment, they receive a manikin to practice the CPR skills on. Our instructor leads a Zoom call to evaluate and provide feedback to the student using a hands-on CPR skills checklist.
